Domaine La Prade, Sauvignon Blanc, Languedoc Roussillon

A crisp, lively Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of green apple, pink grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is dry and refreshing, with a rounded mid-palate and an elegant finish.

Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier

Fresh pear and almond notes infuse this delicately structured, stylish Pinot Grigio. Dry, yet rounded, with a refreshing finish.

Featherdrop Hill, Sauvignon Blanc

Lively aromas of gooseberry, passion-fruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalize the palate and offer a refreshing clean finish.

Rose Wine

Poggio Alto, Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy

With a delicate pale pink colour and an elegant nose of acacia flowers, this light bodied dry rose is delightfully refreshing.

Côtes du Rhone, Victor Berard

Conde Valemar, Rioja Crianza

Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of subtle spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish.

Conde Valemar, Rioja Reserve

Argentina

1895 By Norton Malbec

Sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish. Bottle £25.00

Champagne

Laurent Perrier, La Cuvee, Champagne, France

Well defined, subtly rounded with expressive flavours. The fruit progressively emerges to reveal a finely balanced champagne displaying great length on the finish. Bottle £63.00

Laurent Perrier Rose, Brut NV, Champagne, France

Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. It has great length and is rounded and supple on the finish. Bottle £83.00

Sparkling Wine

Prosecco, Costaross, Pordenone, Venezia, Italy

With a bright, clear colour and fine persistent mousse, this Prosecco is harmonious and fruity, with a delicate flavour and a clean, crisp finish.

Ca'del Console Prosecco, Extra Dry

A classic Prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish. Bottle £29.00

Jaxon's Cellar

Red

Château Caronne Ste Gemme, 2008, Haut-Médoc

Blackberry and blackcurrant fruit are given extra complexity by cigar box and floral notes. There is excellent finesse and depth all the way through to the finish. Bottle £55.00

Gigondas, Les Murailles Ferraton Pere & Fils, 2016

Full of dark fruit, cola and spice. Creamy and supple on the mid-palate, then firms up, turning tannic and warm on the finish. Bottle £55.00

Château Batailley 2008, Pauillac

Drinking well, this classic is approachable with leafy undertones & dense cassis. Dark & broody yet quite the charmer. Bottle £75.00

La Dame de Montrose, Chateau Montrose, 2010, St Estèphe

Dense purple, its oodles of fruit, luxurious mouth-feel and terrific finish make it a sleeper of the vintage. Bottle £90.00

Chateau Chantemerle, 2009, Medoc

Medium bodied with lovely violet, cassis and cedar flavors with supple, firm tannins that provide the backbone. A wine that should age well over the coming decade. Bottle £90.00

Réserve de la Comtesse, 2008, Château Pichon-Lalande

This wine offers a nice, fruity mouth-feel and a peppery finish which is what we expect of a Pauillac wine. The vintage is already mellowing out and doesn't impose itself too heavily; elegant and fine, it is already pleasant to drink today. Bottle £100.00

White

Montagny, Premier Cru, Henri de Villamont

Richly vibrant white burgundy, offering characteristic aromas of red apple and grilled nuts, and a creamy texture on the palate cut with some citrus freshness. Lovely balance and length complete this fine expression of the Henri de Villamont style. Bottle £55.00

Saint Aubin 1er Cru Charmois 2016 Vincent & Sophie Morey

Complex aromas of peach and smoke, with Saint-Aubin's natural creaminess offset by the energy balance of this excellent vintage. Bottle £60.00
